

Geology Exam (ASBOG)

TBPG utilizes the National Association of State Boards of Geology (ASBOG®) examination for Texas P.G. licensure. The ASBOG® exam is given in two parts: the Fundamentals of Geology exam (FG) and the Practice of Geology (PG) exam.

Proof of passing scores on both the Fundamentals of Geology and the Practice of Geology portions of the exam are required to be licensed in geology.

If you took the ASBOG® examination(s) in Texas, your test scores should be on record at TBPG, and no further proof is required. However, if you took the ASBOG® exam in another state or jurisdiction, please submit a Verification of other licenses form to another state or jurisdiction to request verification of your passing scores be sent to TBPG. Applicants are responsible for any charges for verification of examination scores.

To register for the next ASBOG® examination(s), please submit a completed Exam Request Form with all required materials and \$25 fee to TBPG by the application deadline. For applications to be considered for the exam, all exam request materials must be received by TBPG on or before the deadline.
