 - 1. Direct the board to discontinue geoscience firm registration (non-statutory); TBPG Rules 22 TAC 850.10, 850.62, 851.10, 851.20, 851.30, 851.80, 851.85, 851.101, 851.102, 851.103, 851.104, 851.105, 851.106, 851.107, 851.111, 851.112, 851.151, 851.152, 851.156, 851.157, 851.159.
 - 2. Direct the board to cease routinely opening unlicensed public practice complaints against expired licensees who failed to timely renew (non-statutory).
 - 3. Direct the board to further develop policies guiding the administrative dismissal of complaints by staff, specifically to provide staff clear direction to handle continuing education

- complaints unless aggravating circumstances require board involvement (non-statutory).
- 4. Direct the board to publish its penalty matrix on its website (non-statutory).
- 5. Amend Texas Occupations Code, Section 1002.452 to increase the board's maximum administrative penalty amount from \$100 to \$1,500 per day for each violation. The application of the maximum penalty should be limited to only the most serious offenses (statutory).
- 6. Apply the Sunset across-the-board recommendation regarding complaint processing for complaints against the board (statutory).
- 7. Apply the Sunset across-the-board recommendation regarding alternative dispute resolution (statutory).
- Civil liability immunity for Advisory Committee members.
- "Emeritus" license status of a PG license.
