This report is submitted on behalf of the Texas Board of Professional Geoscientists (TBPG) as required by Executive Order RP49. The Texas Board of Professional Geoscientists is a small agency with 6 FTE's occupying 960 square feet of office space in the William P. Hobby Building; a state owned and managed facility. For this reason and because of the size and scope of the agency, we are not able to measure energy usage nor are we able to monitor savings for reducing energy consumption. The agency has established a Resource Efficiency Plan as part of our State Agency Energy Savings Program and has included everything possible to ensure that our agency does its part to conserve energy.
