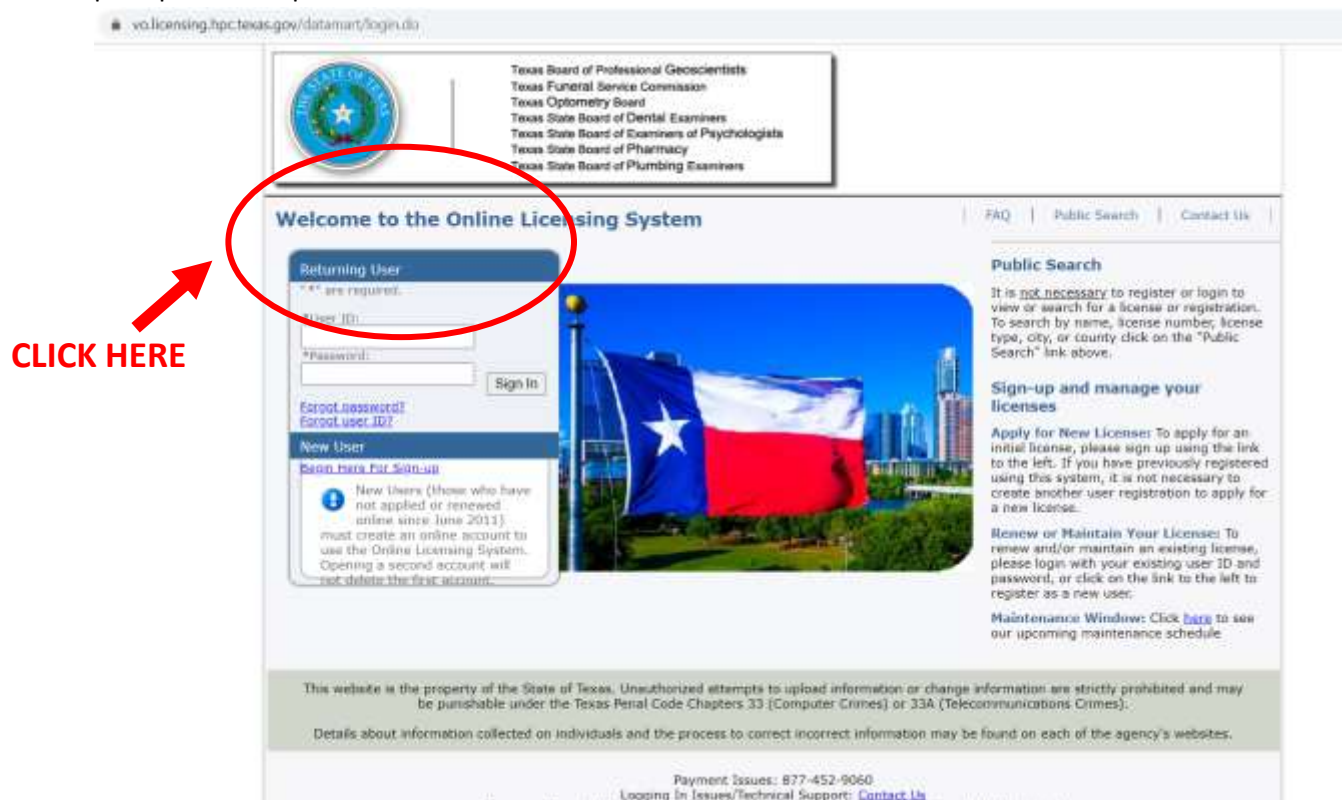


How to Renew a PG License Online

1. Go to <http://tbpg.state.tx.us/> and click "Online Services". Select "Online Licensing Services"



2. Once that link brings you to the Online Licensing System, sign in with your user id and password. If you don't have an online account set up, select "Begin here for sign up" and follow the prompts to set up an account.



3. Once the login is successful, you will see a quick start menu.
